



Adult Education System in Sweden

This 5-day course is for language teachers/trainers working with asylum seekers, immigrants and refugees. Participants will develop their knowledge, confidence and skills around cultural diversity. The course will also give an introduction to the Swedish Adult Education system and show some best practises about how we integrate VET training and L2 learning in Sweden.

Teachers/trainers from different countries will share different approaches to promoting lifelong learning, employability skills and empowerment across different countries and systems. The course will enable the development of best practice through sharing and exploring the effectiveness of different theoretical frameworks and approaches and practical tools. The course will also give an introduction to the Swedish adult career and guidance system.

Over the 5 days, participants will gain practical skills and knowledge about:

- The Swedish Adult Education system
- L2 training courses
- VET training in combination with language learning
- Pedagogical approaches and methodologies about language learning for adults
- The Swedish model "Jobbtorg"
- Knowledge about the Swedish career and guidance system
